

#### **History**

During the 1910 World Missionary Conference (WMC) held in Edinburgh, Scotland, it was decided that a central library was needed as a depository for information on missions and as a reference and research tool for mission boards. Dr. John R. Mott, as part of the Continuation Committees of the WMC, secured the financial assistance of Mr. John D. Rockefeller, Jr. to officially establish the Missionary Research Library in 1914. It was created as an agency of the Foreign Missions Conference of North America (FMCNA), and its headquarters were located at the FMCNA's building on the 19<sup>th</sup> floor at 25 Madison Avenue in New York City. The Library, which officially opened in June 1914, was intended for use by a variety of people and organizations: missionaries on furlough and in the field; those in missionary organizations or on mission boards; professors of missions and students studying the topic; scholars; anthropologists; the government; other libraries; and the general public.

Dr. Mott served as chairman of the MRL committee which also included individuals such as Harlan P. Beach, Daniel J. Fleming, Dr. A. W. Halsey and Edmund D. Soper. Dr. William I. Chamberlain, Dr. Cornelius H. Patton, and Dr. Robert E. Speer were also members of the committee. It was said that, "The roll of the committee members and of those closely associated with the Library...includes the names of almost every great missionary statesman and scholar in North America."

The director of the Library was Charles Harvey Fahs, who was also its curator and had once been research secretary to Dr. Mott. The first librarian was Hollis Hering, who served until 1948. According to the pamphlet *The Missionary Research Library, A Unique Service Agency: What It Is, What It Does*, published in the 1960s:

Mr. Fahs long held the place of an elder statesman in the North American missionary activities, and his vast knowledge, keen insight, and wise counsel were invaluable in the

formulation of missionary policy. Miss Hering's contribution both to missions and to librarianship was widely recognized. It was only through the devotion of these two persons that the Library was able to function through the years of financial stringency.

Rockefeller provided the substantial original funds, with the idea that the entire support of the Library would be carried on by missionary boards by 1929. In 1929, however, MRL could not afford the FMCNA buildings anymore and it was moved to the newly complete Brown Tower at Union Theological Seminary (UTS), thanks in part to efforts by UTS President Henry Sloane Coffin. The partnership between UTS and MRL was very beneficial to both organizations; the FMCNA continued to help maintain MRL even after in 1950 after it became the Division of Foreign Missions of the National Council of Churches of Christ in the USA.

Upon Fahs' retirement in 1948, the MRL's financial difficulties continued; directors R. Pierce Beaver (1948-1955), Frank Wilson Price (1956-1961) and Herbert C. Jackson (1961-1966) managed to raise funds for the collection and see that it was maintained, but it was not to flourish as it once had. Union's president from 1945 to 1963, Henry Pitney Van Dusen, was supportive of the MRL and did what was possible to keep it functioning. In 1960, the MRL provisionally incorporated with Union. It was finally integrated as one with the UTS Library's collections in 1967. MRL had its own reading room which continued until 1976.

In 2004, the UTS Library became the Burke Library and was fully integrated with the Columbia University Library System.

#### **Collection Scope and Content Note**

The collection is organized in seven series:

- Series 1: Foundation Documents, 1927-1994 (4 boxes, 1.75 lin. ft.)
  - This series contains foundational documents for the Missionary Research Library. "Foundation" includes not just the documents and legal undertakings that established MRL, but also important documents throughout the organization's history, including expansion, relocation, and dissolution.
- Series 2: Committees and Meetings, 1852-1978 (15 boxes, 7.50 lin. ft.)

This series contains specific committees as well as work done as part of a committee. It also holds information related to important, larger meetings not related to committee work. The committees held meetings as well as participated in conferences which pertained to MRL.

This section also contains information on MRL conferences, from planning to implementation, through minutes, reports, programs, papers, and more. It also has information on the various conferences MRL staff members attended that were related to the work of MRL.

- Series 3: Correspondence, 1851-1977 (9 boxes, 4.50 lin. ft.)
  - This series contains letters pertaining to the work and mission of MRL. The correspondence is often with missionaries in the field, church supporters, and other interested parties, spanning several decades.
    - Subseries 3A: Dr. Pierce Beaver, 1948-1955 (1 box, 0.50 lin. ft.)
       The correspondence of Dr. Pierce Beaver shows a small portion of his time while Director of the Missionary Research Library.
    - Subseries 3B: Charles Fahs, 1911-1948 (23 boxes, 11.50 lin. ft.)
      The correspondence of Charles Fahs' was so vast that it can stand as its own subseries. The correspondence of Mr. Fahs gives insight into the inner-workings of the MRL and its work around the world. Correspondence regarding bibliographies was kept in this series.

#### Subseries 3C: Hollis Hering, 1935-1942 (2 boxes, 1.00 lin. ft.)

This subseries contains the specific records for Hollis Hering. Hering received an A. B., Vassar, 1908; graduated Pratt Institute School of Library Science, 1910; M. A. New York University, 1919. She also had worked at the UTS Library, was a member of various organizations such as the American Library Association and the New York Special Libraries Association, and was author and contributor to many publications. Hering held a Grade A Certificate for life – the highest rating given at Albany to professional librarians.

#### • Series 4: Publications and Research, 1876-1976 (19 boxes, 9.00 lin. ft.)

Within this series are manuals, bulletins, brochures, pamphlets, etc. that were printed by the MRL, either for public distribution or internal discussion. This series also includes research that was later used in an MRL publication. This also includes research for research requests, internal and external publications, and general information on libraries in the surrounding areas.

#### o Subseries 4A: Bibliographies, 1938-1965 (4 boxes, 2.00 lin. ft.)

The Missionary Research Library answered many reference questions, both in person and by postal mail. Many researchers, other organizations and institutions were interested in what MRL had to offer regarding specific topics. Hollis Hering and others compiled these lists and called them bibliographies. Many of these lists were internally published as subject guides.

### Series 5: Staff, 1940-1965 (1 box, 0.50 lin. ft.)

This series contains personal and professional papers and official documents from many different staff members of the Missionary Research Library, primarily directors. While the works of Charles Harvey Fahs and Hollis Hering are most prevalent, there are plenty of papers from other directors that contribute to a broader understanding of the long- and short-term work of the library.

#### Subseries 5A: Charles Fahs, 1896-1948 (6 boxes, 3.00 lin. ft.)

This subseries contains the records of Charles Harvey Fahs that was not correspondence. His work was so intertwined with MRL that the lines blurred between what was his personal research and what was for the MRL. He was very active in missionary organizations as well as serving as research secretary to Dr. John Mott from 1911-1914.

Fahs held an A. B. from Northwestern University, 1898; B. D., Drew Theological Seminary, 1901; honorary M. A., Northwestern, 1925. He was editor and manager for a number of publications including those of the Board of Foreign Missions, Methodist Episcopal Church (1902-1911); The World Atlas of Christian Missions (1911), and the World Missionary Atlas (1925). He was married to Sophia Lyons Fahs, also a well-known figure in her own studies.

Included are notes, source materials, and other information related to his life's work.

- Series 6: Museum Objects, [191?]-[197?] (2 boxes, 1.00 lin. ft.)
  This series contains physical objects owned and used by MRL, including official MRL rubber stamps, and an embosser.
- Series 7: Photographs and Film, 1930-1963 (1 box, 0.50 lin. ft.)
   Within this series are photographs of staff, spaces, exhibitions, and all other manner of graphics for the long history of MRL.

#### **Processing**

Metal clips and staples were removed from materials and folded items were flattened. Materials were placed in new acid-free folders and boxes. Acidic items were separated from one another by interleaving with acid-free paper as needed. Any items in an advanced state of deterioration were placed in Mylar envelopes.

The materials in this collection were spread across a large amount of unprocessed records and disorganized boxes. A team of student assistants assisted the project archivist, Brigette C. Kamsler, with the monumental task of discovering all of the records and organizing them into a semblance of order. The majority of the order is therefore artificially imposed. The students who assisted from 2013-2014 were Elizabeth Beller; Sarah Davis; Rossy Mendez; Jazmin Mooney; Virginia Pastor; Jessica Patterson; Cécile Queffélec; and Kristen Leigh Southworth.
