Abstract: International Missionary Council was established in 1921. It linked

missionary councils to discuss issues such as the missionary obligation of

the church, theological education, and the ecumenical movement. Associated with the World Council of Churches in 1939, in 1961, it was integrated with WCC as its Commission on World Mission and Evangelism.

photographs relating to the formation and development of the organization.

History

The first World Missionary Conference was held in Edinburgh in 1910. This conference was concerned with such ideas as evangelization, mission churches, cooperation and unity. The conference concluded it necessary to create an international committee to "serve as a medium of communication between all missionary societies." The Edinburgh Continuation Committee was formed, which would become the International Missionary Council (IMC). The IMC came into corporate existence at the Lake Mohonk Conference in October 1921.

In the beginning, some early functions of the IMC were to study mission problems and disseminate information; to coordinate missionary activities; to unite Christian forces; and to organize area and world mission conferences. These missionary conferences were utilized to stimulate missionary thinking, missionary cooperation and missionary advance. Four notable world conferences were in Jerusalem (1928); Madras, India (1938); Whitby, Canada (1947); and Willingen, Germany (1952).

The IMC was sustained through thirty-five constituent bodies, which were of two kinds: National Christian Councils on the various mission fields of the world and the National Missionary Councils in the west. In addition to the thirty-five constituents, the IMC remained in contact with over twenty other councils and committees on mission fields.

The International Missionary Council was associated with the World Council of Churches early, beginning in the 1930s. A discussion started in 1956 for integration, which came to fruition in 1961. The IMC thus became the World Council of Churches' Commission on World Mission and Evangelism.

Collection Scope and Content Note

The collection is organized in six series:

• Series 1: Foundational Documents, 1944 – 1957 (1 box, 0.25 lin. ft.)

This series contains documents relating to the establishment and organization of the International Missionary Council (IMC). Included are the constitution and bylaws as well as final financial reports.

• Series 2: Board Records, 1913 – 1962 (3 boxes, 1.00 lin. ft.)

This series consists of committee and administrative records. The Committees have to do with the general meetings, as well as how the organization was to evolve throughout its tenure, and discuss significant issues.

Series 3: Correspondence, 1920 – 1959 (1 box, 0.50 lin. ft.)

This series contains correspondence for the IMC, as well as specific correspondence for Lawrence J. MacGregor and John W. Decker during their tenures as treasurer and secretary of the organization.

• Series 4: Conferences, 1921 – 1958 (5 boxes, 2.50 lin. ft.)

The IMC held conferences, also called meetings, to discuss topics related to missionaries and ecumenism throughout the world. For example, the Jerusalem Meeting in 1921 discussed the relationship of missionary societies and churches. The Willingen Meeting in 1958 discussed the missionary obligation of the church. This series is arranged chronologically and contains studies leading up to each conference; images; documents from the gathering themselves; and subsequent reactions.

• Series 5: Organizations, 1922 – 1956 (1 box, 0.50 lin. ft.)

This series contains materials from the IMC's association with the National Christian Council of China when the NCC was studying the IMC for questions such as missionary training on the field and if IMC could hold a conference in China. It also consists of materials relating to the World Council of Churches, including the serious discussion of integration between the IMC and WCC which began in 1956. Other items show the relationship between the IMC and WCC, such as the joint meeting held in Bangkok.

Series 6: General (2 boxes, 1.00 lin. ft.)

Within this series are general materials from the IMC. Included in the papers is a list of archival items in Geneva, published Bulletins, other press releases and funds from the IMC.

Processing

Metal clips and staples were removed from materials and folded items were flattened. Materials were placed in new acid-free folders and boxes. Acidic items were separated from one another by interleaving with acid-free paper as needed. Any items in an advanced state of deterioration were placed in Mylar envelopes.
