# **Printing In the Business & Economics Library**

There are two different kinds of printing systems available for public use in the Business & Economics Library: NINJa printing and Business school printing. (Neither printing system allows color printing at this time.)

#### **NINJa Printing**

Printing from NINJa stations requires authentication through the University Network. To authenticate you must have a UNI (University Network Identification) and Password. NINJa printers are networked to **Library Netstations** throughout the library. Once a print request is made at the Netstation, patrons must approach the NINJa printing terminal, choose the relevant print job from those waiting in the print queue, and enter their UNI and password. Page allowances apply to NINJa printing.
