Biography

A student of Union Seminary, who gained his BD in 1964, Wyndham Anderson also attended Duke University, where he achieved a ThM in 1965. He was ordained to the UCC (Metropolitan Association) on October 1, 1966. He is an active member of the UTS Alumnus Association and a resident of Richmond, Virginia.

Collection Scope and Content Note

The papers consist of a selective collection of correspondence between Wyndham Anderson and faculty at Union Theological Seminary with whom he retained contact after his student days. In addition there are associated clippings and two addresses by John C. Bennett.
