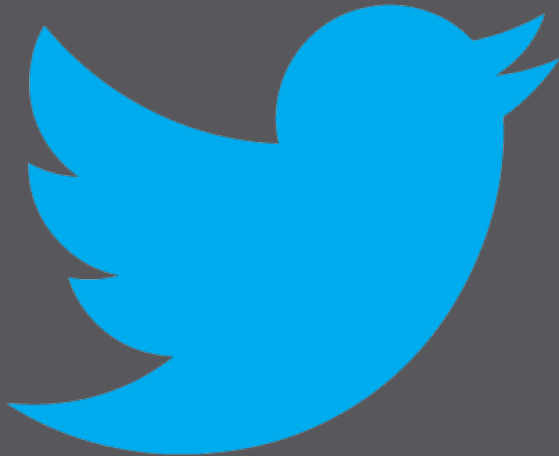

Tips for Twitter

- Personal and Professional
 - Public and Private
- Make it **#BLUE!**
- .@ versus @
- Be conversation (@, RT, MT)
- Take your time

Tweets are not small

LOC archives all of them!

Each tweet has 31 metadata fields!
